Welcome to the 2017 ACM-ICPC Asia Tsukuba Regional Contest

The ACM International Collegiate Programming Contest (ICPC) is a competitive programming competition of the universities of the world operating under the auspices of ACM and the headquarters at Baylor University. The ICPC traces its roots to a competition held in 1977. It has provided gifted students with opportunities to interact with students from other universities and to sharpen and demonstrate their problem-solving, programming and teamwork skills.

In the contests, each team of three students is provided with one computer and given 3-5 hours to solve 8-10 problems. They compete for the privilege of advancing to the ICPC World Finals. Last year's ICPC regional participation included 46,381 students from 2,948 universities in 103 countries. The winning 133 teams from each regional contest advanced to the World Finals held in Rapid City, South Dakota, USA, during May 20-25, 2017.

This year in Japan, 1173 students from 93 universities competed in Asia Japan Online First-Round Contest on July 14, 2017. The winning 43 teams advanced to the 2017 ACM-ICPC Asia Tsukuba Regional Contest during December 16-18, 2017. The further winning teams will advance to the ACM-ICPC World Finals 2018 in Beijing, China, during April 15-20, 2018.

The 2017 ACM-ICPC Asia Tsukuba Regional Contest was organized by Tsukuba Gakuin University in collaboration with the Organizing Committee of the ACM-ICPC Asia Tsukuba Regional Contest and International Information Science Foundation. We would firstly like to express our gratitude to Prof. Kiyoshi Ishihata at Meiji University for managing the judge team and preparing the contest problems, and The ICPC 'Secretaries' Team provided high-quality technical support and service. 
